I am pleased to announce that the ***Pre-arranged Paths (PaPs) for TT2021*** are now published and accessible in PCS and ready for you to order via the following link <http://pcs.rne.eu/>.

To simplify your selection of PaPs, I would like to provide you with the new ***“DigiCat TT2021”*** in which you will find a combination of PaPs for long distance traffics as well as the individual PaPs for all sections you may choose to request the path.

Please submit your path requests for the Timetable 2021 until **14<sup>th</sup> April 2020** by using PCS as the unique booking tool for PaPs.

As the C-OSS I will then decide on the pre-booking results taking the priority rules into account, which have been adopted by the Ministries of Transport along the Rail Freight Corridor.

To support your traffic planning you will receive a preliminary information about the results by the **27<sup>th</sup> of April 2020**.

The draft and final timetable offer (incl. feeder/outflow paths) will then be communicated on **06<sup>th</sup> of July 2020** respectively on **24<sup>th</sup> of August 2020** via PCS.

Further details on the product can be found on our website and in PCS or are downloadable anytime from our Customer Information Platform (CIP), together with all relevant information on the procedures for requesting and allocating capacity (Corridor Information Document Book 4).
