Decision of the Executive Board of Rail Freight Corridor North Sea – Baltic

of 16 July 2025

approving the Implementation Plan 2025 of Rail Freight Corridor North Sea – Baltic

Having regards to

- Regulation (EU) 2024/1679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 13 June 2024 on Union guidelines for the development of the trans-European transport network, amending Regulations (EU) 2021/1153 and (EU) No 913/2010 and repealing Regulation (EU) No 1315/2013 leading to a new alignment of the corridor. Finland decided to make use of Article 8(2a) of the RFC Regulation, meaning that the Finnish IM will not participate in the Management Board of the Corridor. At the same time, Sweden as it is not connected with RFC without Finland, was also not included in the implementation plan.
- Regulation (EU) 913/2010 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22nd September 2010 concerning a European rail network for competitive freight and in particular Article 8(1) and Art. 9 (1).
- The Rail Freight Corridor North Sea Baltic having been established on the 10th of November 2015;
- The draft Implementation Plan was prepared by the Management Board and consulted with the stakeholders between 22.05.2025 and 12.06.2025.

The Executive Board of Rail Freight Corridor North Sea -Baltic:

- 1. Approves the Implementation Plan 2025 of Rail Freight Corridor North Sea —Baltic annexed to this Decision;
- 2. Notes that following the approval of the Implementation Plan, the Framework for Capacity Allocation (FCA), adopted on 2nd December 2024, applies to the Rail Freight Corridor North Sea –Baltic, as defined in this Implementation Plan.
- 3. Mandates the Management Board to publish the Implementation Plan and to report to the Executive Board on progress on the execution of the Implementation Plan, including the monitoring of the performance and in the annual report.
