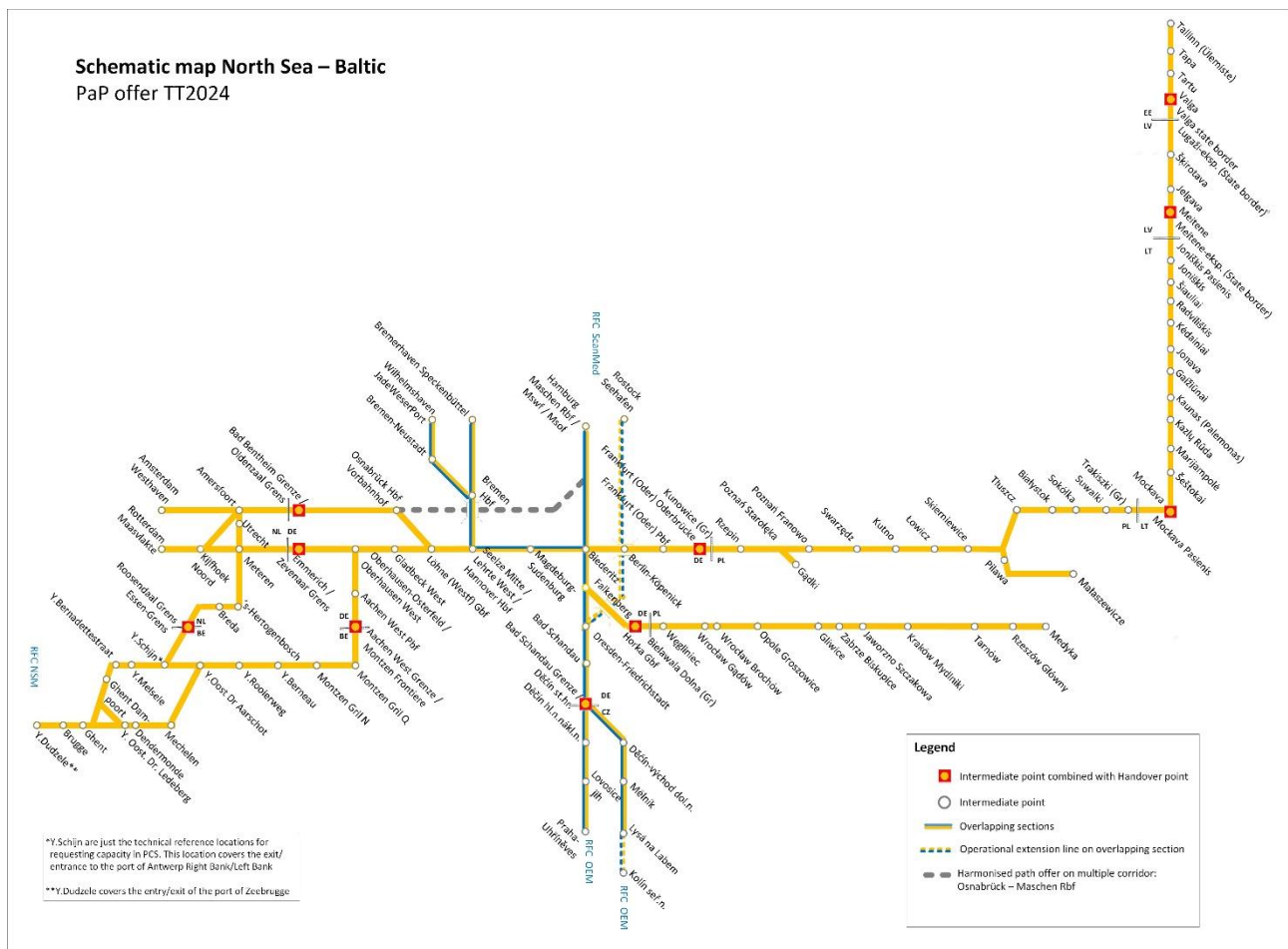

Publication of Pre-arranged Paths (PaPs) for Timetable 2024

I am pleased to announce that the **Pre-arranged Paths (PaPs) for TT2024** are now published and accessible in the Path Coordination System (PCS), the unique booking tool for PaPs, and ready for you to order via the following link <https://pcs-online.rne.eu/pcs/#/login>.

To simplify your selection of PaPs, please find attached to this letter the new **DigiCat TT2024**, which provides all details about the **long-distance PaPs**, **short-distance PaPs** and further **separate PaP sections** for the locations displayed in our schematic map below:



After your PaP selection, I am looking forward receiving your path requests via PCS until April 11th, 2023. As the C-OSS of the corridor, I will decide on the pre-booking results taking the priority rules into account which have been adopted by the Ministries of Transport along the Rail Freight Corridor.

To support your traffic planning you will then receive a preliminary information about the pre-booking results by April 24th, 2023.

The draft and final timetable offer will be published on July 03rd, 2023, respectively on August 21st, 2023 via PCS.

Please find further details on the PaP product on our website, in PCS and on the Customer Information Platform (CIP), together with all relevant information on the procedures for requesting and allocating capacity, the Corridor Information Document (CID).
